

Ohio Third Frontier Internship Program

MIS and OPS students at the University of Dayton qualify for internship opportunities that Ohio's Third Frontier Internship program partially funds. This program will reimburse businesses providing internships up to 50 percent of interns' wages (up to \$3,000 per year per intern) for up to two years for a specific student. Interns may be in their sophomore year or later.

Students must be enrolled in an approved high-tech curriculum. The curricula listed at <http://thirdfrontierintern.ohio.gov> include Physical, Biological, Agricultural sciences; Engineering; Computer Sciences; and Mathematics. We have confirmed that our MIS and OPS students qualify.

Internship positions provided by a business for our MIS and OPS students will most likely be related to Information Technology or Advanced Manufacturing.
